At the center of the musical composition are images of the anointment of Isaiah to prophesy.

The piece explores the language of revelation, epiphany and vocation as it appears one of the grandest Biblical narratives. Utilizing the Hebrew original and the English translation, juxtaposing the sublime and the mundane, the transcendental and the human, the music exploration reflects the grandeur and mystery of texts that comprise the foundation of monotheistic mysticism.
